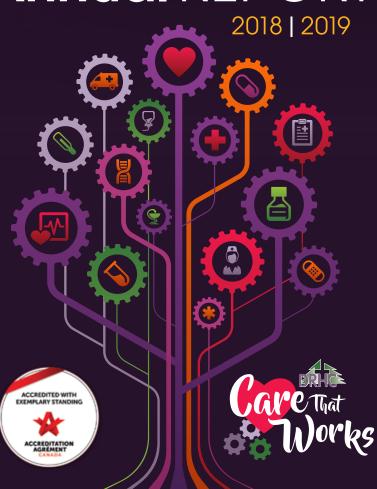

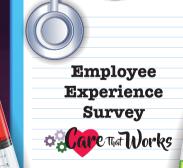

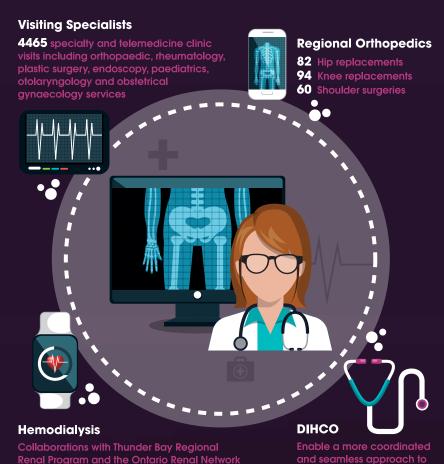

Patient Satisfaction Results:
